

Walkersville United Methodist church has had an adult choir for many, many years. It has been a source of joy for choir members who love to sing and be part of the worship service and for the congregation who enjoy listening. Wednesday night choir rehearsals have been fun. Even though the choir works hard to bring an anthem together, there is a lot of laughter and comradery. It has been said that you could come to choir in a bad mood, but you certainly couldn't leave that way.

For at least the past two years, the adult choir has struggled to maintain the number of members needed to present the anthems in a way that we feel enhances the worship services and, also, displays our quality of music we have established over the years. The lack of choir members has been a critical issue. There have been numerous pleas for new members – we have gained three, but we have lost some. With life events causing a significant decrease in our choir members after March, we will be slightly more than a quartet. This is not a choir. So, it is with a heavy heart and much sadness, that we say, after March 17, 2019, there will be no more Walkersville United Methodist church adult choir. We pray that this church, which has a history of phenomenal musicians, will see fit to support a choir again.

For those services, provision of free room and board in Walkersville.


Specific duties would include assistance with getting dressed, bathing and general grooming; assistance with getting in and out of bed.

EMAIL BLAST REMINDERS:

Just a reminder when asking the office to send a church-wide Email Blast for news and information, the email blasts are **only** sent to the family's designated 'Household' email. There is <u>only one</u> Household email per family. If you need to send information to specific individuals, a church-wide email may not reach everyone. For example: emails being sent to committee members should be sent to them directly, not via a church-wide email.

Reminders to all members: Please make sure the office is using the email address you want as your Household email to receive the church-wide Email Blasts. For example: if you are not currently receiving the Saddlebag, your Household email address may need to be updated.

Communication of Church Events

The following protocol was approved by Church Council to communicate church events and building usage:

Any event that affects the body of the church (including events which are taking place outside the facility, such as at someone's home or local restaurant, retreat, etc.) or use of the facilities should be on the church calendar. Every event, meeting, outside contractor, in-house repair that may affect use of the facility or may create a conflict with other events MUST be communicated in writing (preferably via email) to the Administrative Assistant. The email should be sent to <u>secretary@walkersvilleumc.org</u> and should include space being requested, date and time of event, any need for prep (decorating, food prep, etc.), any post-event need (such as paint drying time, clean-up, removal of decorations, etc.). This will allow for notification of the appropriate people to assure the facility is clean and available with no conflicts. Your cooperation is appreciated.
